SELLING OF PERSONAL INFORMATION	<b>SECURITY LIFE OF DENVER INSURANCE COMPANY AND THE AFFILIATED COMPANIES LISTED BELOW (“SLD” or “us” or “we”) DO NOT SELL YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION.</b>
SHARING OF PERSONAL INFORMATION	The California Consumer Privacy Act, as amended by the California Privacy Rights Act, defines “sharing” as the sharing, renting, releasing, disclosing, disseminating, making available, transferring, or otherwise communicating orally or in writing your personal information to a third party for cross-context behavioral advertising. <b>SLD DOES NOT SHARE YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION</b> as “share” is defined in the California law. Other state laws may define “share” differently.
Categories of personal information we collect	<p>The categories of personal information we collect depend on the product or service you have with us or your other relationship or interaction with us. SLD collects information that identifies, relates to, describes, or references you, or is capable of being associated with, or could reasonably be linked, directly or indirectly, with you, including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• your name, postal address, email address, Social Security number, driver’s license number, passport number, phone numbers, and other similar identifiers;</li> <li>• bank account and credit information;</li> <li>• business contact information;</li> <li>• demographical information such as sex, disability, citizenship, primary language, immigration status and marital status;</li> <li>• employment-related information and information collected as part of an application for employment, such as work history, information from background checks, references, resumes, and personnel files;</li> <li>• medical and health-related information;</li> <li>• biometric information;</li> <li>• audio and visual information such as call and video recordings;</li> <li>• other personal financial information; and</li> <li>• information you or anyone authorized by you to provide your personal information to us.</li> </ul> <p>If you visit our website, we may collect your IP address, geolocation data such as device location, log-in information such as your username and password, page clicks, and other information regarding your interaction with our website.</p>
Sources of personal information we collect	<p>The sources of personal information from which we collect personal information about you include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• you directly, or from a person acting on your behalf or who was authorized or asked by you to provide us information, including when you submit applications or forms to us, engage with customer service, or interact with us through the use of our website or job application system;</li> <li>• agents and distributors, including writing, servicing and general agents on your life insurance policy or annuity contract;</li> <li>• public records or widely available sources, including public records and information that are made available by federal, state, and local government entities;</li> <li>• outside companies that provide data to us to support activities such as human resources and workforce management, customer service, fraud prevention, underwriting, and claims processing, including data brokers, credit reporting agencies, and data analytics providers; and</li> <li>• outside companies as part of providing products and services, completing transactions, supporting our everyday operations, or managing and developing our business. Examples include third party administrators, reinsurers, and parties involved with mergers, acquisitions, and other transactions involving transfers of all or part of a business, or a set of assets.</li> </ul>
Purposes for which we collect, use, and disclose personal information	<p>The business purposes for which we collect, use, and disclose your personal information depend on the product or service you have with us or your other relationship or interaction with us and include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• to provide our products and services to you;</li> <li>• to support the ongoing management and maintenance of our products and services, including to maintain accounts, process payments, provide customer service, and to perform collections, underwriting, claims processing, and account notification functions;</li> <li>• to obtain services and support from our third-party service providers, contractors, professional services and business partners, and financial institutions;</li> <li>• to support our everyday operations, including to meet legal, risk, and compliance requirements, perform accounting, monitoring, and reporting, enable information security and anti-fraud operations, verify or enhance the quality of services, support audit functions and investigations, legal requests and demands, defend legal claims, and comply with laws, regulations, policies, procedures, and contractual obligations;</li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• to manage, improve, and develop our business, including to improve our products and services, conduct data analytics, conduct user experience surveys, support customer relationship management, and evaluate mergers, acquisitions, and other transactions involving transfers of all or part of a business, or a set of assets;</li> <li>• to support employment, job application, and human resources activities and workforce management;</li> <li>• to operate our facilities and maintain our infrastructure, and</li> <li>• other uses permitted under applicable laws.</li> </ul>
<b>Third parties to which we disclose personal information</b>	<p>All financial companies need to disclose personal information to third parties to run their everyday business. The categories of third parties with which we disclose the categories of personal information identified above for a business purpose include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• anyone authorized by you to receive your personal information or to which you request that we provide your information;</li> <li>• outside companies in connection with providing our services and products, completing transactions, supporting our everyday operations, and business management and development, including our third-party service providers, contractors, professional services and business partners, financial institutions, third party administrators, distributors and agents affiliated with your policy, program administrators, and reinsurers;</li> <li>• the issuers of your life policies and annuity contracts for which we provide administrative and reinsurance services;</li> <li>• government entities;</li> <li>• outside companies in connection with human resources activities and workforce management, including recruiting agencies;</li> <li>• parties involved with mergers, acquisitions, and other transactions involving transfers of all or part of a business, or a set of assets, and</li> <li>• our auditors and legal and financial representatives, and other outside companies involved in collections and conducting investigations.</li> </ul>
<b>Sensitive Information used or disclosed by us</b>	<p>Certain types of personal information are defined as “sensitive” personal information under applicable law. Such sensitive personal information is used and disclosed by us only as necessary to provide products or services as reasonably expected by individuals who have sought to obtain or have received such products or services, or otherwise as permitted by law, and is not subject to a right to limit its use and disclosure.</p>
<b>How long we retain your personal information</b>	<p>SLD retains your personal information as long as reasonably necessary for the purposes disclosed in this notice and for other related business purposes, as required or permitted by applicable laws and regulations, and pursuant to our records retention policy. We may need to retain personal information beyond these retention periods due to regulatory requirements or in response to a regulatory audit, investigation, or other legal matter.</p>

<b>Individual Rights</b>	<b>Description</b>
<b>Right to deletion</b>	You have the right to request that SLD delete your personal information, unless it is necessary for us to retain it for a purpose permitted by law.
<b>Right to know and access</b>	You have the right to request that SLD disclose to you the following covering the 12-month period prior to your request: (1) the categories of personal information we have collected about you, (2) the categories of sources from which your personal information is collected, (3) the business or commercial purpose for collecting your personal information, (4) the categories of third parties to whom we disclose your personal information, (5) the categories of personal information we have disclosed about you; and (6) the specific pieces of personal information we have collected about you.
<b>Right to correct</b>	Your right to request that SLD correct any inaccurate personal information about you that we maintain, taking into account the nature of the personal information and the purposes of the processing of the personal information.
<b>Right to fair treatment</b>	We will not discriminate against you for exercising any of your privacy rights, such as by denying you products or services, charging you different prices or rates, or providing a different level or quality of products and services, or retaliate if you are an employee, job applicant or independent contractor.
